

The following forms must be returned by ALL STUDENTS who are enrolled for the 2020-2021 school year at St. Thomas in grades Kindergarten - 8th (current Pre-K 4 through 7th). ALL FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO YOUR CHILD'S HOMEROOM TEACHER BY **MONDAY, MARCH 2, 2020**.

- B6T Transportation Form: Required for ALL STUDENTS entering grades Kdg-8. This form must be filled out REGARDLESS if your child(ren) take a bus. These forms are sent to the school districts to determine if busing is available in your area. If your area does not have busing available, you may be eligible to receive financial reimbursement in lieu of your busing, but you WILL NOT be eligible for Aide in Lieu if this form is not returned. Each form must have an original parent signature (as required by the State of New Jersey), so therefore you must fill out one form per child, and send the original form into your child's homeroom teacher. We can not accept a scanned/emailed/faxed copy. Any child who returns a form after the deadline will not be guaranteed a spot on a bus (if one is available). - Proof of Residency Form: Most districts require proof of residency in order to qualify for busing or aide in lieu. Please return the form and required documents to your child's homeroom teacher. Download and print the form here: [PROOF OF RESIDENCY FORM.pdf](#)
- Non-Public Textbook Form: In order to issue your child textbooks of any kind, this form must be completed. Please download and print the form here: [Textbook Form New 2019.pdf](#)

PLEASE NOTE: When filling out the forms, if it asks for your "Public School District" or "Resident District Board of Education", this is the school district where your child would go to school if they attended public school instead of St. Thomas, and it MUST be filled in. For example, if you live in Parlin and your child attended a public school, your Resident Public School District would be either Sayreville or Old Bridge. If you are unsure what your public school district would be, you can look it up online.
