As you know, the spread of Coronavirus (Covid-19) has quickly become a major concern in our state. Should a decision need to be made to close our school, we believe we can "keep the learning going," even if we are closed. In order to ensure that there are not interruptions in our students' education, we will have a 12:20 dismissal on Monday, March 16 so that all faculty can be trained on the technology necessary to support virtual learning.
