

Supply List

St. Thomas the Apostle - First Grade

ALL STUDENTS are asked to come to school **EACH DAY** with the following:

- AT LEAST 3 masks (cloth or disposable)
- A personal-sized bottle of hand sanitizer (to be kept at their desk)

The students will receive the following items from our school bookstore during the first week of school, so kindly send in **\$6.00** in a sealed envelope with your child's name. *You do not need to purchase these items prior to the school year, as these items will be ready for students on the first day of school.*

- 4 - Soft cover notebooks
- 1 – homework notebook, 1- reading notebook, 1-writing notebook

As the children complete each notebook, we will ask for an additional \$1.50 to cover the cost of each new book needed.

Additional Supply List (to be purchased prior to the first day of school)

- 2 box of sharpened #2 pencils (Ticonderoga brand is preferred)
- 2 – Pink Pearl erasers (or similar type)
- Scissors – fiskars (pointed edge for kids) are good
- 2 large glue sticks (please, no liquid glue)
- 5 folders with bottom pockets
- Crayons – 16 count
- 1 pencil box (must be able to fit all items listed above)
- 1 – washcloth for lunchbox (to be used as a “placemat” during snack/lunch)
- 1 - computer mouse (wired preferred) *Be sure to label with the child's name.
- Hefty 18qt Plastic Storage Bin with Gray HI-RISE Stackable Lid (\$6 [Target link](#))

Due to the amount of classroom supplies requested, students will be asked to bring in each item on different days throughout the first week of school. Your child should not bring all items in on the first day, however these items should be purchased prior to the first day:

- 2 Large boxes of facial tissues (more may be requested during “cold season”)
- 1 container of baby wipes
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- One container of disinfecting wipes (if possible)

**** Please keep in mind that these supplies will be used daily and may need to be replenished throughout the year ****

1. Please label all supplies, including lunch boxes, clothing, and backpacks
2. Clear contact paper will be needed to cover all soft workbooks that will be given out in September. This will enable your child to keep their books protected from the daily use each book will have. Please have all books soft workbooks covered by the end of September.

Technology Fee: All students in grades 1-8 will be given a ChromeBook or laptop to use while they are a student at St. Thomas the Apostle. These students will need to submit a \$50 Technology Fee to cover the cost of maintenance of the device, minor repairs, lost power cords, etc. before their device is issued. This fee is payable by cash or check made out to St. Thomas the Apostle School.

Class Fee: \$25.00 - due September 9, 2020. This fee is for special occasions, seasonal parties, and the Diocesan Home School Association Dues and Assessments. Please send cash in an envelope with your child's name on it. If you choose to pay by check, please make the check payable to **St. Thomas the Apostle School**, however cash is preferred.

ALL STUDENTS are asked to come to school **EACH DAY** with the following:

Here is a list of supplies your child will need for the school year.

- 6 cursive writing books \$1.50 each (2 for homework, 1 class book, 1 creative writing, 1 reading, 1 Spanish notebook)

These items must be purchased in school. Please send in \$9.00 in an envelope with your child's name on it by the first Friday of the school year.

We may be asking for additional supplies during the year, but for now supplies needed from home and the items needed daily are:

- A pink eraser
- A small box of crayons – 16 or 24 count only, because any larger box will not fit in the desks and pencil cases. NO MARKERS, PLEASE.
- A glue stick
- A four pack of low odor, chisel tip dry erase Expo markers. (Any colors are fine. No fine tip please.)
- 1 box of Ticonderoga sharpened #2 pencils.
- 1 pair of safety scissors
- 1 box of erasable colored pencils
- 1 YELLOW highlighter
- A SOFT pencil case. The hard boxes do not fit in the desks. (MUST fit all items listed above)
- 1 12-inch ruler
- 2 large boxes of facial tissues
- 1 container of baby wipes
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes (if possible)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Four folders (no side pockets, please and no folders with a glitter cover)
One folder will be for daily use, one test folder, one Language Arts folder, and one Spanish folder.
- Computer mouse (wired preferred) *Be sure to label with the child's name.
- 2 Jumbo Book Socks
- Hefty 18qt Plastic Storage Bin with Gray HI-RISE Stackable Lid

1. Please label all supplies, including lunch boxes, clothing, and backpacks.
2. All supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year.

3. ALL HARD covered books are to be covered in either a paper book cover with the book title and your child's name on the front cover or with a book sock that fits properly.
4. ALL SOFT workbooks must be covered in CLEAR contact paper. Many of the workbooks are the same size, and clear contact enables your child to find the proper book more easily. It also lasts longer.

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
