## Remote Learning Information

All St. Thomas the Apostle School Families will have the option to choose remote learning for their child(ren) for the 2020-2021 academic year. Please see below for the guidelines regarding remote learning.

- Once remote learning has been chosen for your child, he/she will remain on this program until AT LEAST the end of Quarter 1 (November 6, 2021), or until the Governor of NJ has lifted the State of New Jersey Public Health State of Emergency.
- If the student starts in-person and then chooses to change to remote learning, we must receive notice of this choice in writing, and they will need to remain remote as stated above.
- If a child has a documented exposure to Covid-19 that requires him/her to quarantine, they will be allowed to participate in remote learning during this time as long as we have a doctor's note stating this need.
- Links for the live-streamed classes will only be shared with students who are enrolled in the remote learning option.
- All students will be expected to attend all scheduled classes via live-stream in order to be marked present for the school day.
- When the students are participating in a live class, they are expected to behave in a manner befitting a classroom. They will be dressed appropriately, seated properly at a desk or at a table, with no distractions.
- All students will be expected to turn all work in on time, as if they were participating in in-person classes. If there is a written assignment or project that must be turned in, it is the responsibility of the parent to bring the assignment to the school on or before the date that it is due.
- If there are any supplies required from the school, it will be the responsibility of the parent/family to retrieve the items from the school building. The school staff will not deliver or mail any items to the student.
- As long as the student(s) are enrolled at St. Thomas the Apostle School, all tuition agreements will be met.
