

## 2<sup>nd</sup> GRADE SPELLING: HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT LIST

**Directions:** Complete each daily spelling assignment on a clean page in your LA notebook. Be sure to write your St. Thomas school heading, the Spelling Assignment number, and number each of your spelling words for all assignments. (#3 Story Time words do not need to be numbered.)

1. **Practice Makes Perfect:** Write each of your spelling words three times each in your very best handwriting.
2. **ABC Order:** Write your spelling words in ABC order.
3. **Story Time:** Write a story using at least ten (10) of your spelling words. Underline the spelling words in the story.
4. **Who? What? When? Where? How?:** Write a question for each of your spelling words. Underline the spelling word in each question.
5. **Rainbow Writing:** Write each of your spelling words in a different color crayon or colored pencil.
6. **Phone Fun:** Write each of your spelling words once. Then, look at your telephone keypad. Make each letter into the numbers on the keypad. Now write your spelling words using that code. (Example: dog 364)
7. **Vowel Finder:** Write each of your spelling words once. Circle the vowels in each word.
8. **Test Prep:** Have an adult give a practice test at home. Be sure the practice test is checked and signed by an adult. Write any word you get wrong 3x each.
9. **Synonyms:** Write each of your spelling words once and then write a synonym for that word next to it. (Example: warm hot)
10. **Antonyms:** Write each of your spelling words once and then write an antonym for that word next to it. (Example: warm cold)
11. **Sentence Art:** Write a sentence for each of your spelling words. Under each sentence, draw a picture to go with it. Make sure to underline your spelling word in the sentence and color your pictures.
12. **Fun Flowers:** Draw a picture of a great big flower. Write each of your spelling words on one of the flower petals or on a leaf. Draw extra flowers if you run out of room. Color your picture.
