We may be asking for additional supplies during the year, but for now supplies needed from home and the items needed daily are:

- 1 calculator with radical sign. This will be used in both math and science classes.
- Mini thesaurus and dictionary
- 1 sturdy canvas tote bag or string bag (will be used by the students to carry textbooks between classes so must be a good-quality bag)
- Ear buds
- Computer mouse (wired or wireless) \*Be sure to label with child's name.
- Case for laptop/Chromebook (at least 16 inch) Devices WILL NOT be issued to students without a case

Please note that all textbooks must be covered with either book socks or brown paper. Workbooks are to be covered in clear contact paper.

#### Helpful Hints

- 1. All supplies and lunch boxes should be labeled with the student's full name and homeroom.**
2. Please check supplies periodically to be sure that none are missing, damaged, or in short supply.
- 3. Please label all uniform clothing, especially gym clothing.**
- 4. All jackets, sweaters, and coats should be labeled with the child's name.**

Technology Fee: All students in grades 1-8 will be given a Chromebook or laptop to use while they are a student at St. Thomas the Apostle. Devices for students in grades 1-4 will be kept in the school building, however students in grades 5-8 will be bringing them home nightly to complete assignments. All students will be charged a technology fee, which is still to be determined. As soon as an acceptable fee is decided upon by the administration, families will be notified and the fees will be collected.

Grade 8 Class Fee: Due to the extra activities that Grade 8 participates in, such as Ring Day, retreats and trips, Baccalaureate Mass, and Graduation, to name a few, the class fee will be assessed in two payments; one in the fall and one in the spring. Please send the first payment of \$200 to your child's homeroom teacher by September 9, 2021. This fee also includes your child's yearbook, so you do not need to order one for them unless you would like a second copy.
